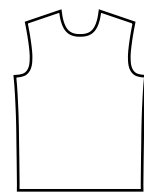


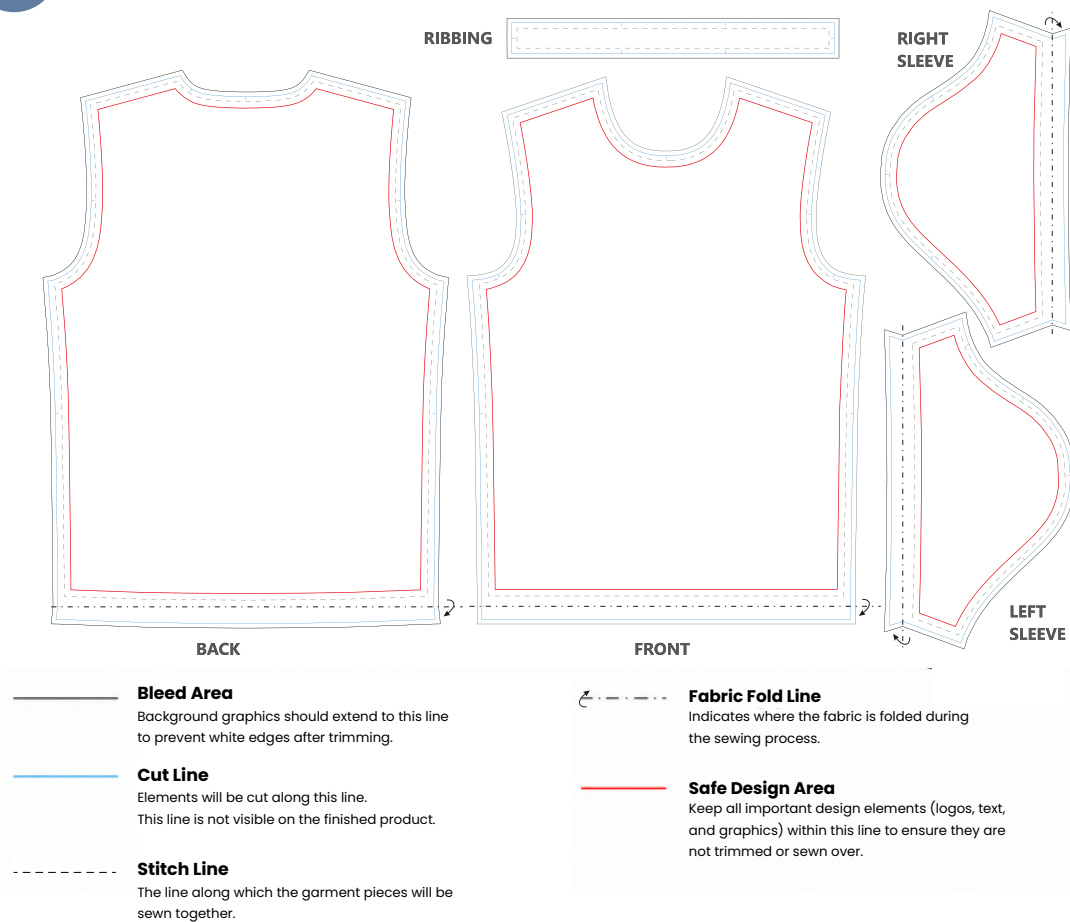
INSTRUCTIONS

FOR PREPARING PRINT-READY ARTWORK

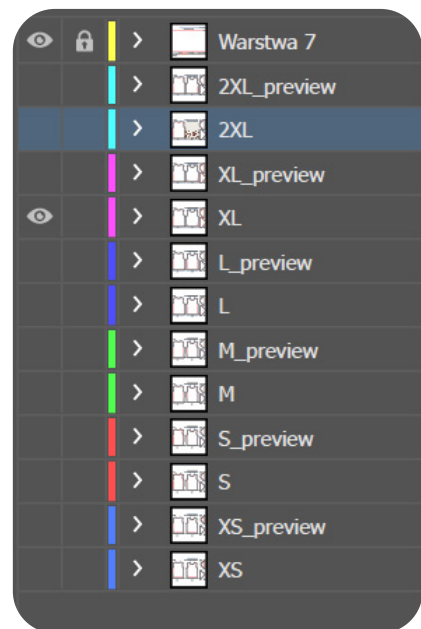


Applicable to sublimation products, including:
jerseys, hoodies, sportswear, accessories.

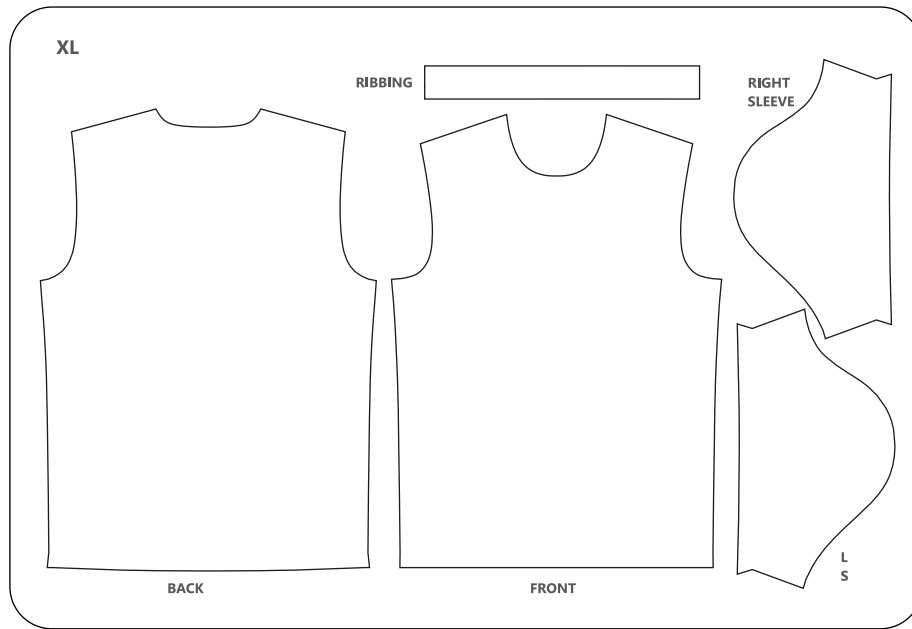
1 TEMPLATE STRUCTURE



2 SELECTING THE SIZE



In the Layers panel, select the appropriate size (e.g. S, M, or L).
The visibility icon () should be enabled only for the working layer of the selected size. Hide all other layers by turning off their visibility icons.



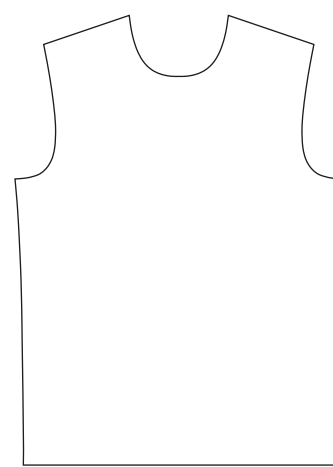
TIP

Work only on the layer corresponding to the ordered size. In this example, the 2XL size has been selected.

3 APPLYING THE DESIGN – CLIPPING MASK

Recommendations:

- Use vector graphics or high-resolution images.
- At 100% zoom, the artwork should remain sharp, with no visible pixelation or blurriness.
- Extend the background beyond the bleed line (solid black outline).
- Create a clipping mask (Adobe Illustrator: Ctrl + 7).
- In the Links panel, embed all linked images.

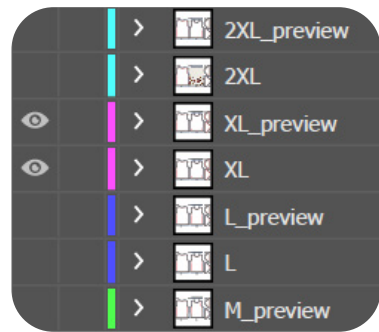


4 SAFE DESIGN AREA

To verify your design, enable the Preview layer for the same size, located above the working layer. All important design elements should remain inside the red safe area.



- Logos
- Text
- Numbers
- Faces
- QR codes
- Other important design elements



IMPORTANT
Elements placed outside the red safe area may be trimmed, sewn over, or partially hidden in the finished product.

5 CHECKLIST

Before saving your project, make sure that:

- ☐ The correct size has been selected.
- ☐ All linked images have been embedded.
- ☐ All artwork is high resolution.
- ☐ A clipping mask has been applied.
- ☐ The background extends to the bleed line.
- ☐ All logos are placed within the safe design area.
- ☐ The design has been checked using the Preview layer.

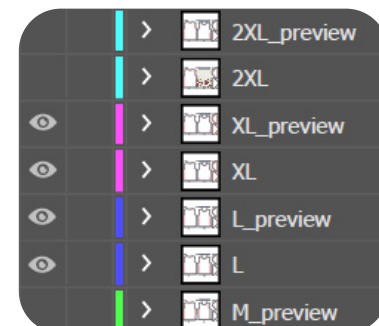
IMPORTANT
Failure to embed linked images may result in reduced print quality and printing errors.



* COMMON MISTAKES



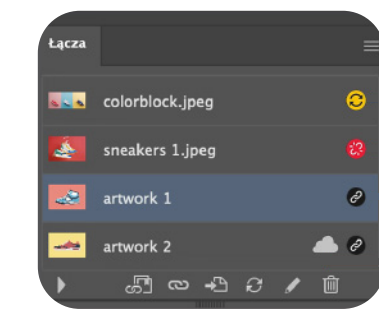
X The logo is placed on the stitch line.



X The design was created using the wrong size template.



X The background does not extend to the bleed line.



X Linked images have not been embedded.

If you create your design in another graphic design program, simply follow the same file preparation guidelines to ensure the best printing results.
